What is MyCardOberhausen?

Dear parents, dear children and adolescents, dear providers of BuT (Bildung und Teilhabe, Education and Participation) services,

the introduction of MyCardOberhausen will change the use and billing of Education and Participation services.

The multiple application for services is now replaced by an online billing procedure!

Eligible users will receive the MyCardOberhausen and access to an online system.

You can then present the MyCardOberhausen to a service provider so that the latter debits the bill amounts.

In addition, you have the possibility to see whether a service has been granted and what the service providers have billed.

We wish everyone a lot of fun in participating in social and cultural life.

The offered services

Educational services for children, adolescents and young adults up to and including 24 years of age:

Excursions and multi-day trips

The costs of multi-day trips or one-day trips with the school or the day-care facilities are covered.

School needs package

Pupils receive benefits for the school equipment in the 1st and 2nd School half-year (for example to pay for a school backpack or for booklets).

School transport costs

The necessary school transport costs for pupils who are dependent on a ticket can be covered to reach the nearest school if another party does not cover the costs.

Tutoring

The costs of supplementary tutoring are covered if they are appropriate and additionally necessary to achieve the school objectives.

Joint lunch

The costs or expenses for joint lunches in schools and day care facilities are fully covered.

Participation services for children and adolescents up to and including 17 years of age:

Children and adolescents receive 15 euros per month for club, cultural/sports or leisure/holiday offers.

Eligibility

All children, adolescents and adults up to and including 17 and 24 years of age are eligible for BuT services if they receive one of these benefits:

- Services according to SGB II
- Services in according to SGB XII
- Child supplement (Kinderzuschlag) according to the Federal Child Benefit Act (BKGG)
- Housing benefit (Wohngeld) under the Housing Benefit Act (WoGG)
- Benefits under the Asylum Benefits Act (AsylbLG)
